Navigation Tools

No stylus needed

(however special one can be purchased)



Use of finger gestures



Navigation Tools

- Touch Screen Tips
 - Touch: Choose an icon
 - Touch & Hold: Show options
 - Drag: Scroll or move slowly
 - Flick: Scroll or move quickly
 - Zoom in/out: Pinch



Navigation Tools

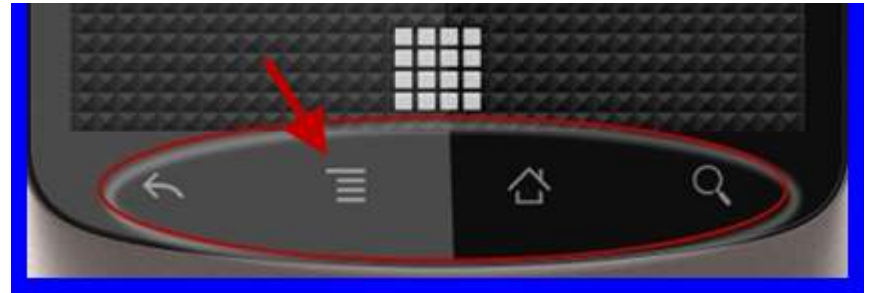
Every Android has navigation tools found at the bottom of the device:

- Menu
- Home
- Back
- Search



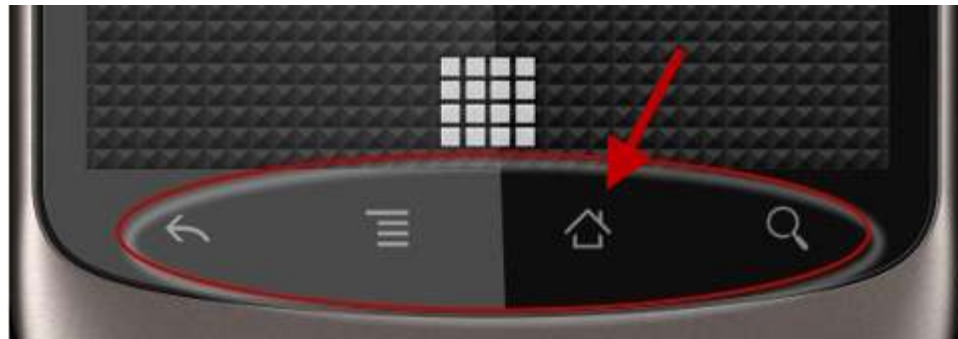
Menu

Menu button may look somewhat different on each device, could be lines stacked on top of each other, or actually say menu



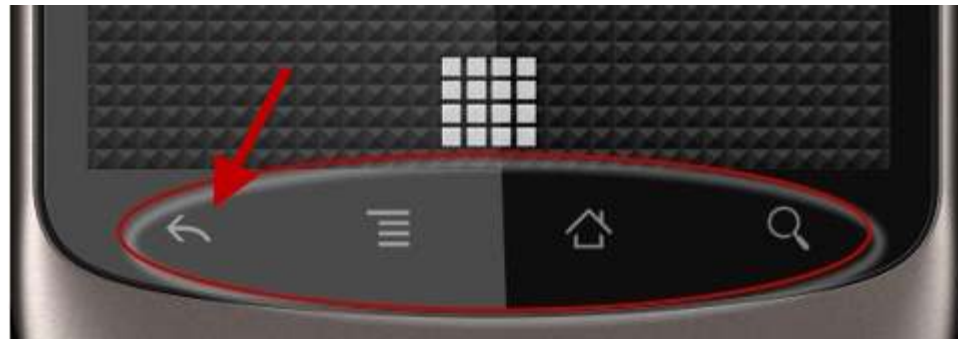
Home Button

- Takes the user to central home screen.
- Does not close any applications
- Great Navigation tool to “Minimize” PointCare



Back

- Takes the user to the previous screen
- Can also act as a “Save” in PointCare

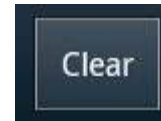


Notifications



Icons at the top of the screen notify you about messages and phone status. To see your notifications touch the status bar and drag it down. Touch a notification to select it.

To dismiss notifications touch "Clear"

Certain Applications are included on the Android Device:

- Calendar
- Contacts
- Maps



Applications



- Device is for Company use only, phone # shouldn't be given to personal contacts.
- Texting is not permitted
 - Security & Cost
- Personal accounts should not be loaded, such as:
 - Facebook
 - Twitter
 - Personal E-mail
 - Etc.



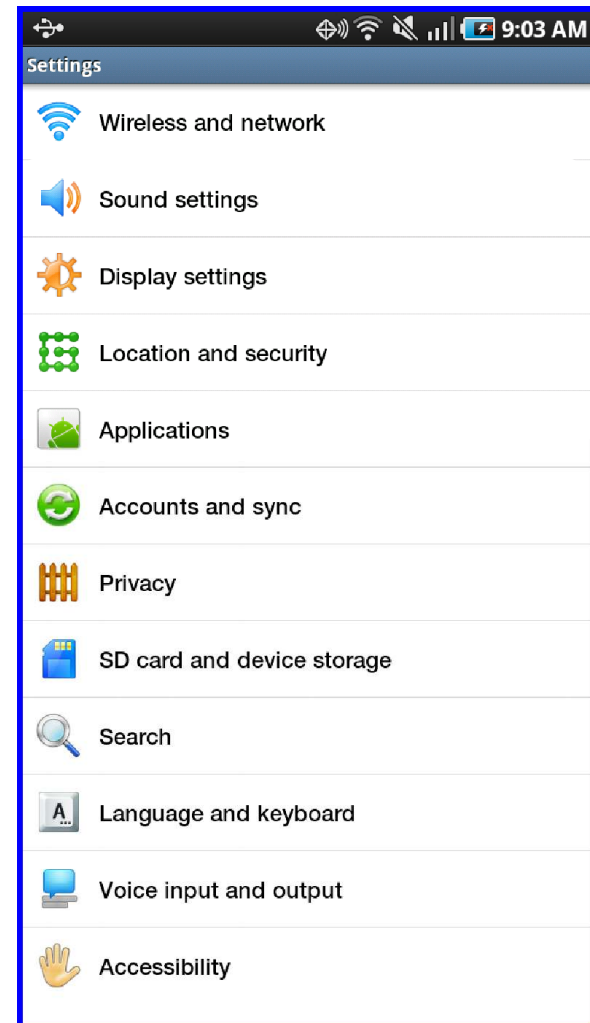

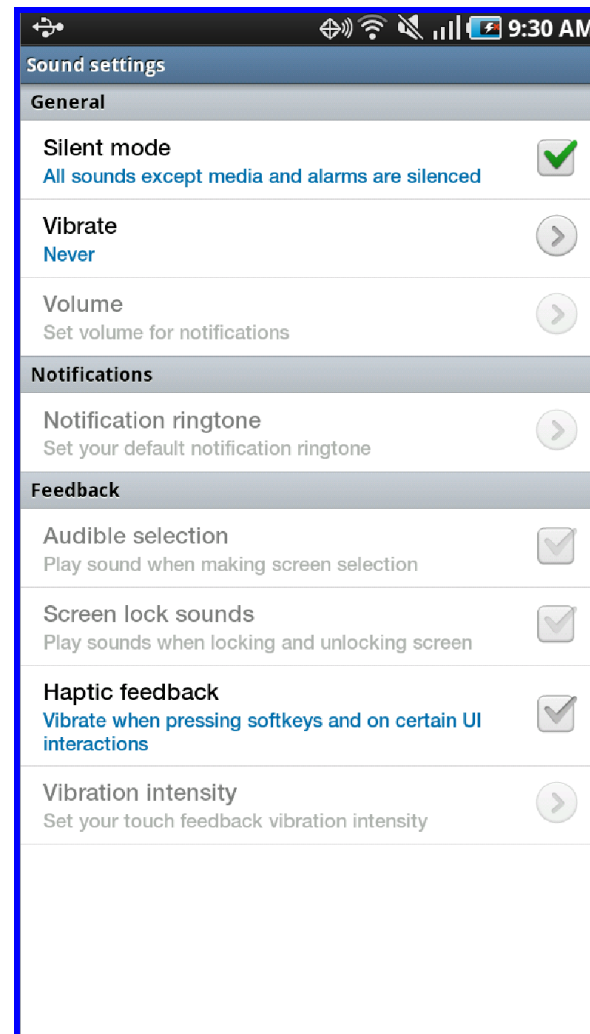
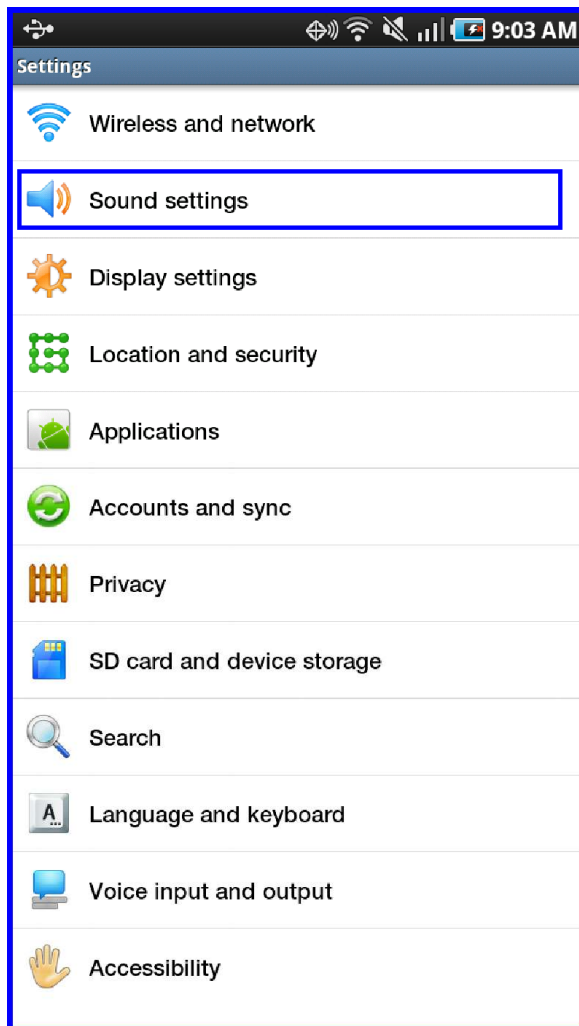
- Voicemail should be set per SolAmor guidelines

- **Read and sign the SolAmor Hospice Device use guidelines**



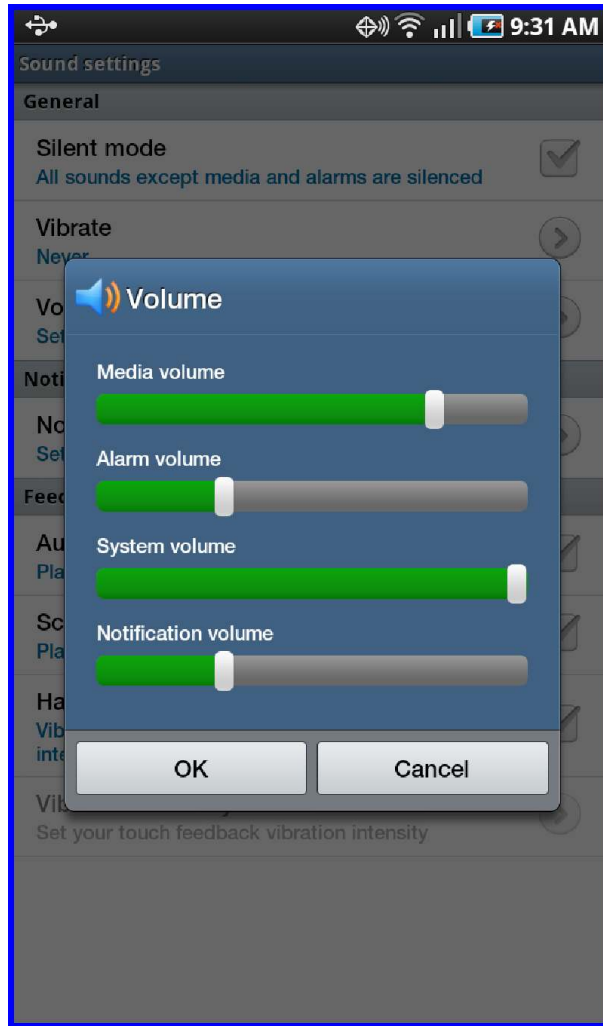

Four Volume Levels

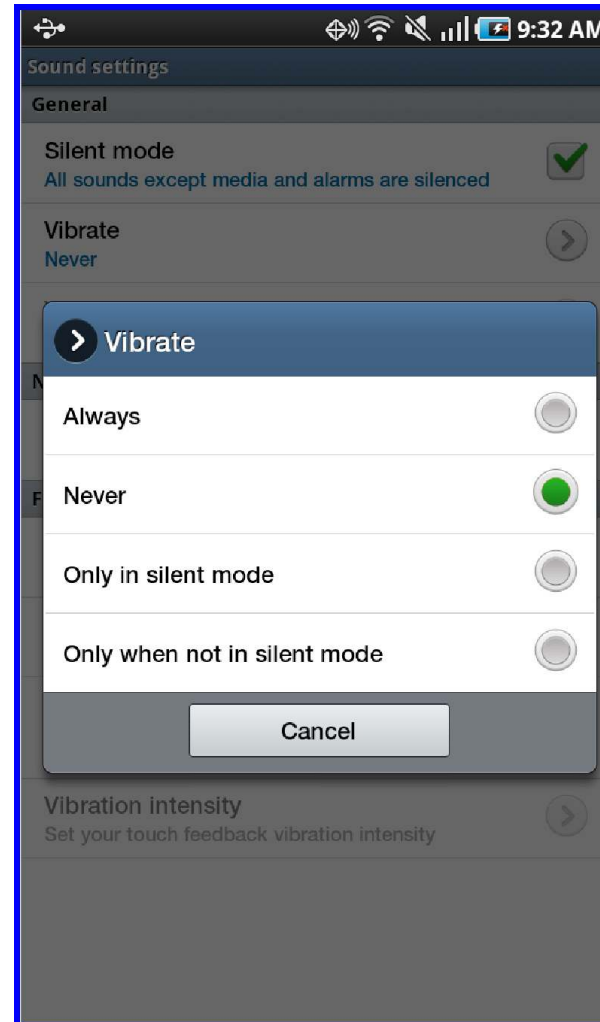

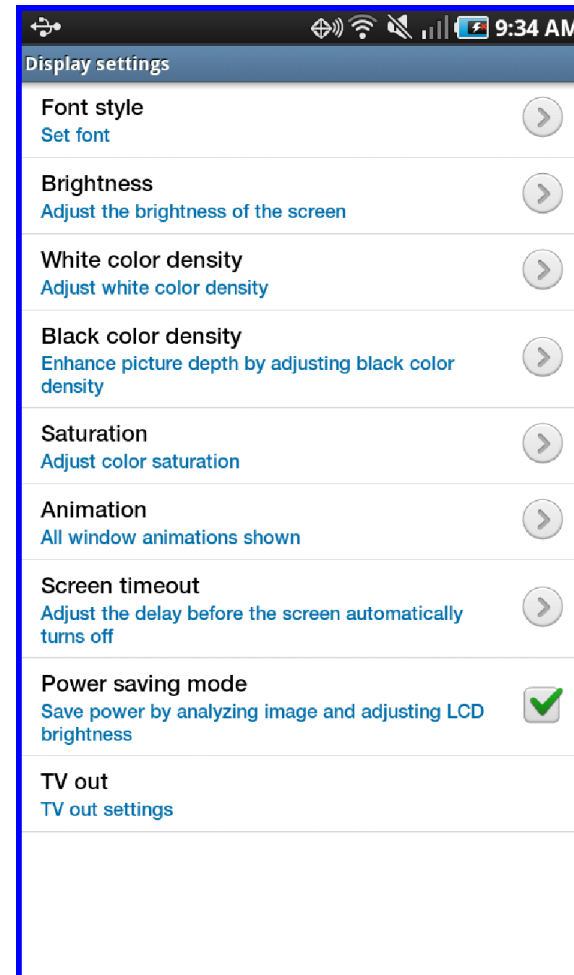
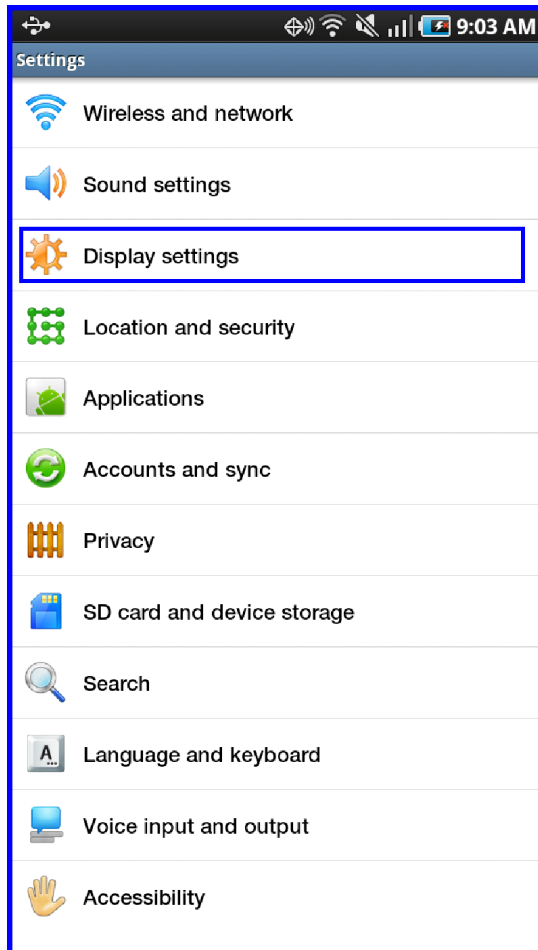


Sound Settings

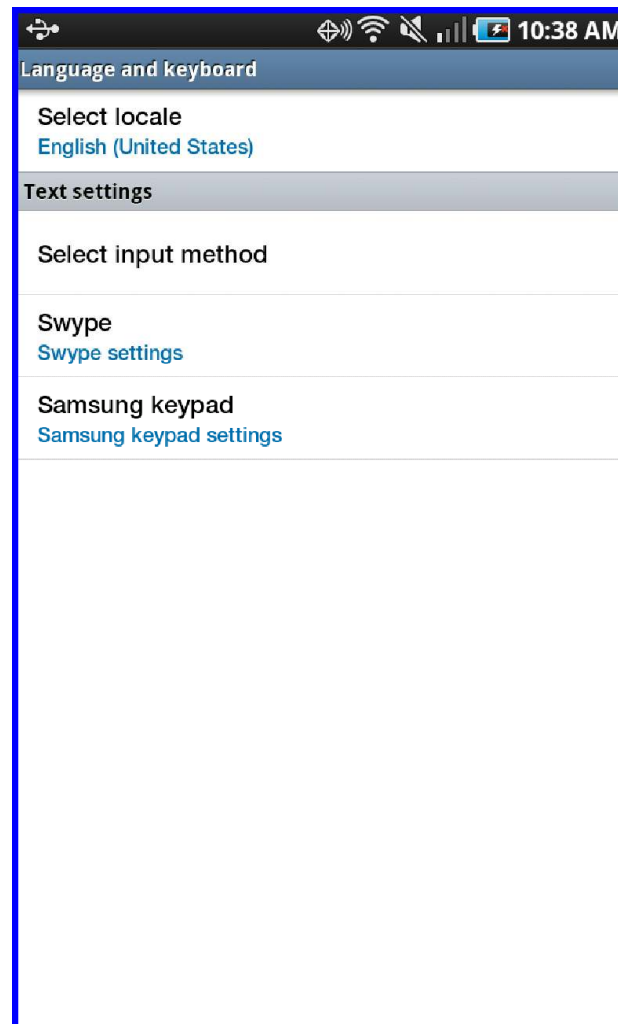
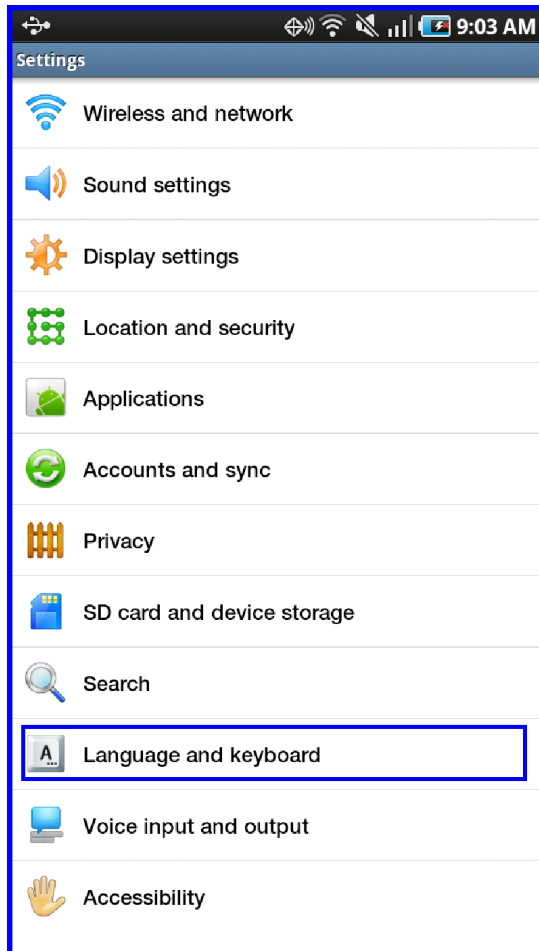
- Users can establish Appropriate Sound Settings to ensure patient care is not disrupted

Keyboard Input



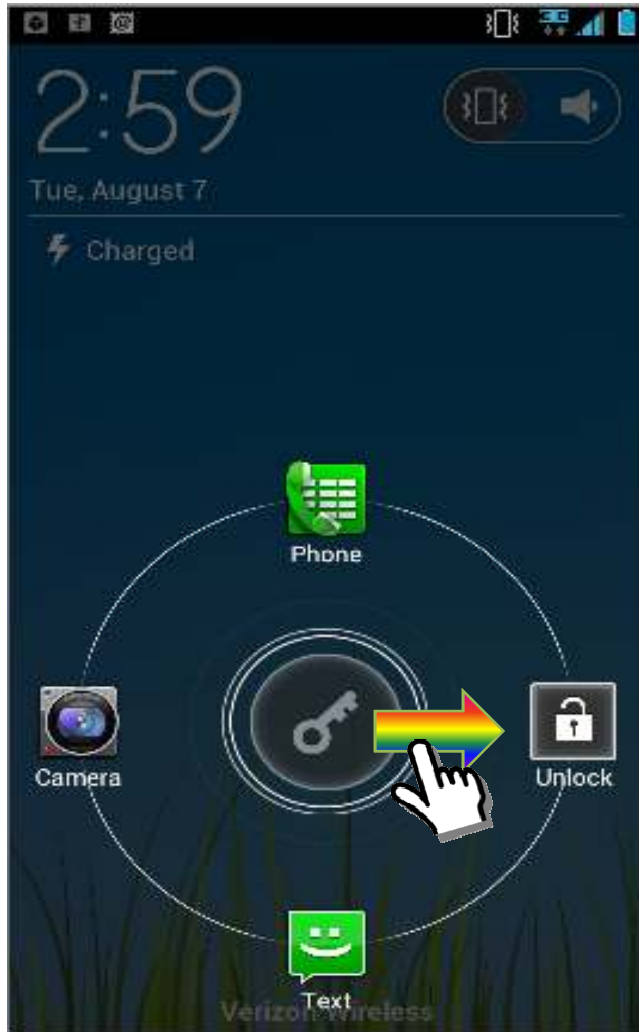
Starting Device
